

MICHIGAN CREEK - JEFFERSON LAKES

Michigan Creek Campground: Take US 285 South over Kenosha Pass and down into South Park. Turn right in Jefferson and take the good gravel road to the Michigan Creek Campground. Look for mushrooms in the campground as well as the area along the creek past the campground for about one-half mile.

Jefferson Lakes Campground: The Jefferson Lakes campground is also reached by turning left in Jefferson. Most of the forested area is public land, so you can stop along the road and look in likely places. This area is about 9,500', so the best time to look is late July through the end of August. CMS members have found Morels, Leccinum, Galerina and a large variety of other species. Large quantities of *Armillaria mellea* are also sometimes found here on dead Aspen.
